The purpose of the Cert IV in Aged Care Work is in line with the vision of Baptist Community Services (BCS) to develop a suitably qualified workforce specifically for aged care. The need to address staffing shortages in aged care has occurred due to the ongoing worldwide shortage of Registered Nurses and compounded by the role limitations of the Assistants in Nursing (AIN) and Care Service Employees (CSE). The organisation identified the need for a career pathway for aged care workers and the need to retain specialised aged care workers within the industry.
