For women and children escaping domestic violence

At BCS Chisholm Care we're passionate about empowering lives and building communities.

BCS Chisholm Care offers crisis and medium term accommodation for women and children who are escaping domestic violence.

BCS Chisholm Care provides individual townhouses located in the Macarthur area, in a secure and confidential environment, allowing older children to remain with their families.

At BCS Chisholm Care, our staff are caring, skilled and empathic, and on-call 24 hours. We are experienced with the issues facing women and children who are escaping domestic violence and the complexities of being homeless.

BCS Chisholm Care also offers support in areas including

- Housing
- Relating to government or other agencies
- Domestic Violence support groups
- Parenting skills
- Budgeting and financial counselling
- Referrals for legal advice
- Court support

BCS Chisholm Care provides accommodation for women and children for up to three months.

Families are provided with their own townhouse and are asked to self-cater, attend weekly meetings and engage in a case plan and living skills program.

All families are supported to achieve independence through a case management process, including outreach support, at the conclusion of a program.

Crisis Accommodation

There is an initial key deposit of \$50 and rent is calculated at 25% of client's fortnightly income.

Medium Term Accommodation

There is an initial key deposit of \$50 and rent is calculated at 25% of client's fortnightly income.

There is also a bond of \$200 and a fee of \$50 per fortnight for utilities (water, gas and electricity).

Criteria for BCS Chisholm Care

- Accommodation is available for women and children only (boys under 16)
- Accommodation is available through agency referral only
- Women must be in paid employment or receiving a Government Benefit
- No drug, alcohol or unmanaged mental health issues
- No visitors
