BCS Darcy House provides a safe space for street-based sex workers and people who are homeless or marginalised in the Port Kembla and surrounding areas.

At BCS Darcy House, people are supported to address issues such as health, drug and alcohol dependence, mental illness and homelessness.

Showers (soap, shampoo, towels provided)
